Report on FAO Symposium on Agroecology

The International Symposium on Agroecology for Food Security and Nutrition (18-19th September), held in Rome, was the first FAO event on agroecology in history. It turned out very successful and can be seen as an important step forward for the support and promotion of agroecology. There were more than 300 participants from governments, farmers' organizations, social movements, NGOs and key scientists working on agroecology. La Via Campesina and other representatives from civil society plaid a very important role during the two-days event. Africa Seed System under threat. The denunciation of AFSA

"The Alliance for Food Sovereignty in Africa (AFSA) is deeply concerned about the recent acquisitions by multi-national seed companies of large parts of SeedCo, one of Africa's largest home-grown seed companies. Attracting foreign investment from the world's largest seed companies, most of who got to their current dominant positions by devouring national seed companies and their competitors through mergers and acquisitions, is an inevitable consequence of the fierce drive to commercialise agriculture in Africa. Important issues for the Committee on World Food Security (CFS)

The CFS is the common body for the UN on Food Security and Nutrition. This 41st session will take place in Rome October, 13-18th. Members of the <u>Civil Society Mechanism to CFS</u> will meet on October 11-12 to prepare for CFS. You will find available documentation for the CFS <u>here</u>. CFS will deal with many important issues. We would like to highlight three of them:

- Principles for Responsible Agricultural Investments (RAI). Hopefully the principles will be adopted at CFS, but it's not sure yet.
